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Most important symptoms/effects, acute and delayed

To our knowledge, adverse effects in humans have not been reported. Eye contact can result in irritation. In animal tests, reduced activity and shortness of breath were seen at high exposure.

Indication of immediate medical attention and special treatment needed:

A specific antidote against this substance is not known. Treatment is as for a general chemical. Gastric lavage and/or administration of activated charcoal can be considered.

5. FIRE FIGHTING MEASURES

Extinguishing media

Foam, CO₂ or dry chemical. Soft stream water fog or fine water spray if no alternatives. Contain all runoff.

Special hazards arising from the chemical:

The combustion of the product may generate toxic or irritating gases.

Special protective actions for fire-fighters:

Isolate fire area. Evacuate downwind. Wear full protective clothing and self-contained breathing apparatus. Do not breathe or contact smoke, gases or vapors generated.

6. ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES

Personal precautions, protective equipment and emergency procedures:

Keep people away from and upwind of spill/leak. Avoid contact with spilled product or contaminated surfaces. Use personal protective equipment. When dealing with a spillage do not eat, drink or smoke.

Environmental precautions:

Minimise spread. Keep out of drains, sewers, ditches and water ways.

Methods and materials for containment and cleaning up:

Isolate and post spill area. Wear appropriate protective clothing and prevent material from entering waterways. Absorb spills with inert material and place in waste containers. Wash area with water and absorb with further inert material.



7. HANDLING AND STORAGE

Precautions for safe handling:

Avoid contact with skin and eyes. Ensure adequate ventilation. Keep away from: sparks, open flame and direct sunlight.

Conditions for safe storage, including any incompatibilities:

Store locked up in original packaging. Keep tightly closed in a dry, cool and well-ventilated place. Keep away from direct sunlight.

8. EXPOSURE CONTROLS / PERSONAL PROTECTION

Appropriate engineering controls:

Use in ventilated areas. Keep containers closed when not in use

Personal protective equipment:

Eye and face protection: When handling wear eye protection, waterproof gloves, boots, hat and cotton overalls

Skin protection: Wear appropriate chemical resistant clothing to prevent skin contact depending on the extent of exposure. During most normal work situations where exposure to the material cannot be avoided for a limited time span, waterproof pants and apron of chemical resistant material or coveralls of polyethylene (PE) will be sufficient. Coveralls of PE must be discarded after use if contaminated. In cases of appreciable or prolonged exposure,

coveralls of barrier laminate may be required.
